## **DFG Addendum (Germany)**

DFG's eligibility criteria for this call can be found in DFG form 50.01 "Guidelines Research Grants Programme".

DFG regulations concerning First Time Applicants will not be taken into account for this call.

German researchers from non-university research institutions must comply with their <u>duty to cooperate</u> (Kooperationspflicht).

## Additional Documents File:

There are no additional documents that are mandatory for every application. However, here are some examples for documents that may be added to the proposal for the DFG side, if applicable:

- Statement by the ethics committee (see the DFG's <u>SSH FAQ</u> for further information on statements by an ethics committee)
- Documents mandated by the funding module requested (e.g. statement from the host institution for a Temporary Position for PI, statement from the university for the Replacement Module)
- Cooperation agreements (see DFG form <u>41.026e</u> and <u>41.026ae</u> for templates)

Once the Principal Investigator has submitted the joint proposal to FAPESP, all proposal documents must be uploaded to elan by midnight (CEST) on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021. No changes to documents submitted via SAGe to FAPESP can be made at this stage. Some pointers for submission in elan:

- Make sure that all PIs requesting funding from DFG are registered in elan well in advance of the deadline! Registrations are processed manually, thus the registration deadline is 7<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- Select funding scheme "Individual Grants Programme/Research Grant" (Einzelförderung/ Sachbeihilfe)
- Call to select: T-AP RRR 2021
- Title and Summary: neither has to be translated from English into German. Instead, the English title and summary may be copy/pasted into the boxes that call for the information in German.
- Non-German PIs are to be added as "Participating Individuals" in the role of "Cooperation Partner".
