Horizon Europe – Structure: €95.5 billion.





EU Framework Programmes: Horizon Europe

- A unique **international R&I programme with scale and scope**
- Truly **multilateral and multidisciplinary**
- Targeting actions with key partners (Region/ Multilateral fora)
- **Top down approach** – predefined problems (TRL 3 onwards);
- All funding on **competitive basis** though calls of proposals;
- **Independent Evaluation**: external experts (peer reviewers);
- Average success rate **15.9%**;
- **Call Information well in advance**: Work Programme (WP) publish every two years (now WP 2023-2024) and WP 2025-2027 under preparation;
- All WPs made public & **+250 calls open** : see **Funding & Tenders Portal**



Horizon Europe - Opportunities

- **Open to the world**

- Open to the world, which means that participants from all over the world can participate in most calls (open by default).

- **Encouraging international cooperation**

- Focus on global challenges, cross-cutting missions, partnerships, and open science policy.

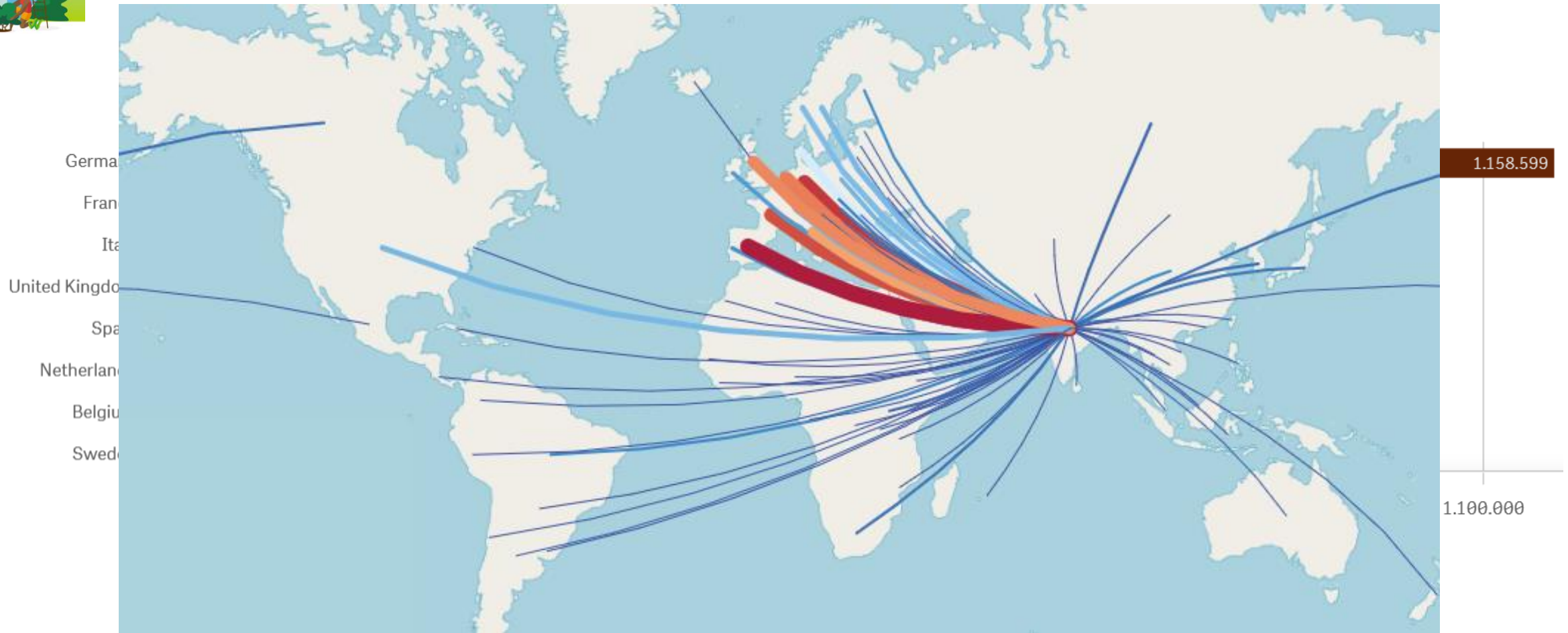



Basic Eligibility Condition - Horizon Europe Proposal

Collaborative projects - Consortia must involve :

- At least **THREE** organisations
- From **THREE** different EU Member States (MS)/Associated Countries (AC).
 - at least one organisation should be established in a **MS**; and
 - at least two other independent legal entities, each established in different **Member States (MS) or Associated Countries (AC)**.
- In addition, entities from other countries (e.g. India) could be included

Who can participate?

Horizon Europe:

- 'By-default' open to almost all countries;
- Any legal entity i.e company, big or small/SME/startups, research organisations, universities, non-governmental organisations, regardless of their place of residence or establishment in "Europe or Non-European countries" – researchers, NGO. Public or private;

India:

- Central/State Government supported or recognized (Public or Private) academic and/or research institution(s);
- National/State funded R&D Labs;
- Scientific/R&D performing Indian industry may participate voluntarily (own funding);

Who is eligible for HE funding?



EU COUNTRIES

- Member States (MS) including their outermost regions -27
- The Overseas Countries and Territories (OCTs) linked to the MS.



NON-EU COUNTRIES

- Countries associated to Horizon Europe (AC) – (currently 19)
- 120 Low and middle income countries: See [HE Programme Guide](#).

- **Other countries**

(not automatically eligible for EU funding, except if stated in call text or considered participation essential by EC/funding body)



SPECIFIC CASES

- Affiliated entities established in countries eligible for funding.
- EU bodies
- International organizations (IO):
 - International European research organisations are eligible for funding.
 - **Other IOs** (not automatically eligible for EU funding, only when announced in the call or exceptionally if their participation is **essential**)

Funding of European partners is as **per Horizon Europe rules** and type of action [RIA & IA]

Exceptional funding

Participation deemed essential by the EC (outstanding expertise, access to research infrastructure/data etc.)

Co-Funding

Bilateral agreement between EU and Third Country



Specific provision

mention in the call text for TC funding

India Participation & funding in non-earmarked HE calls

Own funding

- Legal entities from non-associated countries to HE (e.g. India) may in principle **not receive funding**.
- Normally, they bear their **own costs** – Beneficiary or Associated Partner.

Exceptional Funding

Legal entities from non-associated **may receive funding** from the EU Commission:

1. If the non-EU country (e.g. India) is **explicitly mentioned** in the work programme
2. If the EU Commission considers participation of the relevant legal entity as **Deemed essential** for implementing the action in a proposal and approved by the granting authority!

Example in view of their:

- outstanding competence/expertise
- access to particular research infrastructures
- access to particular geographical environments
- access to particular data

Funding as **per Horizon Europe rules** and type of action [RIA & IA] see HE [programme guide](#)

Consortia Formation

- At least 3 legal organisations from 3 different EU Member States and/or Associated Countries (at least 1 from EU MS);
- Additional legal organisations depending on project requirement from Europe, India, and other non-European countries could be included;
- Partners: multidisciplinary, cross-sectoral & cross-border participation encouraged;
- Gender balance: female participation highly encouraged;
- **One Project Coordinator from EU** - consortium to decide;
- **One lead scientific coordinator from India.**



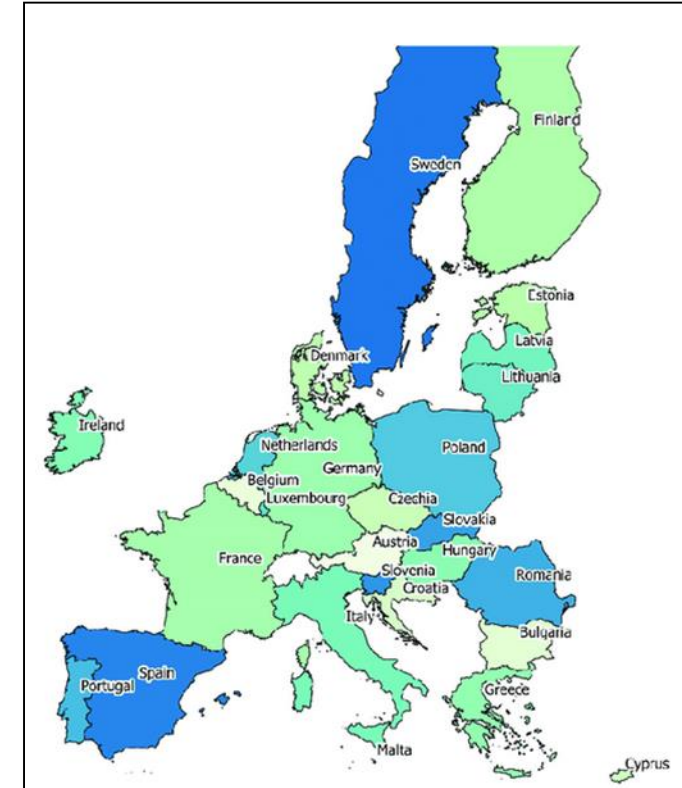

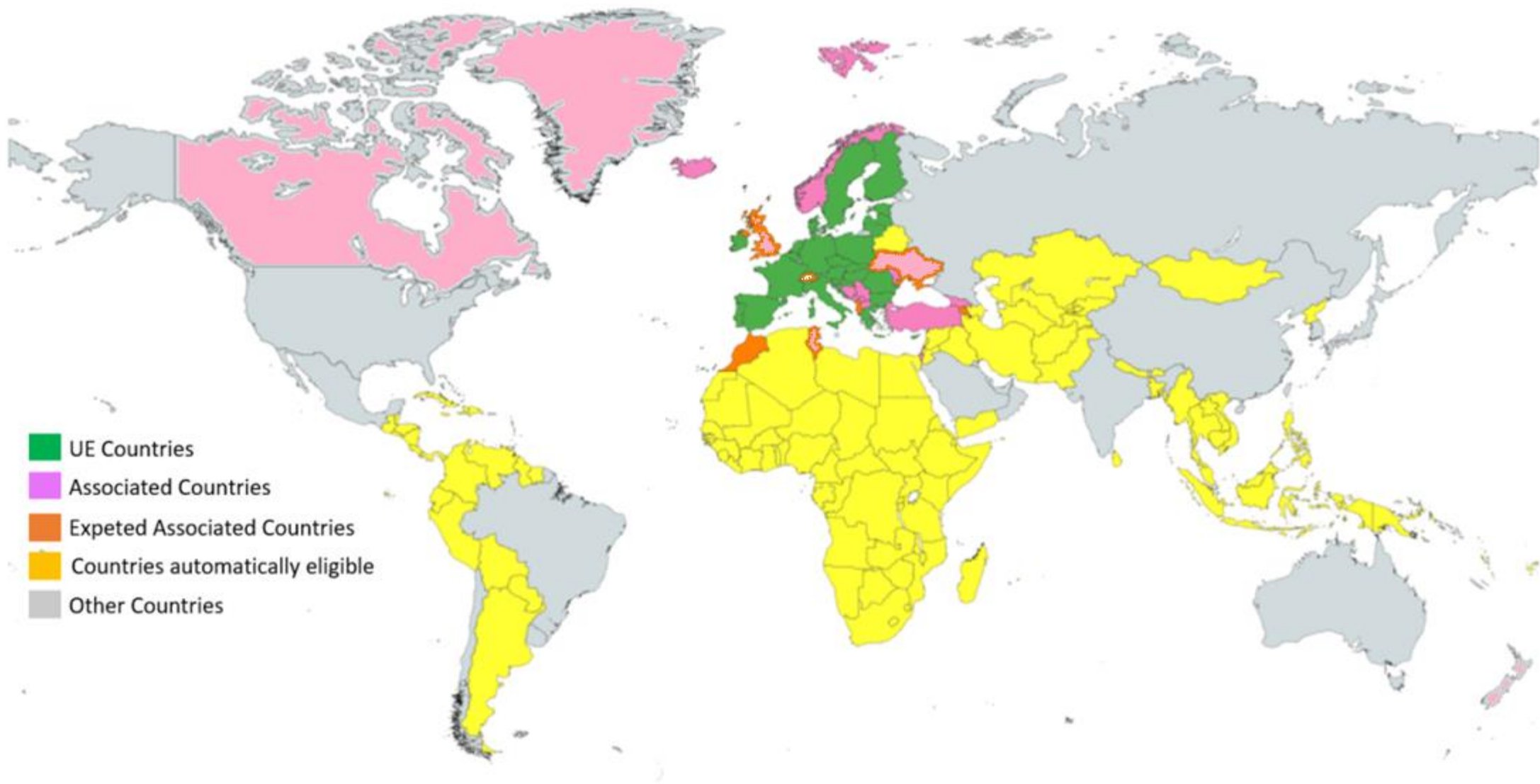

Researchers and innovators from universities and research organisations from India can team up with European partners in the calls for proposals published by the European Commission (EC) under the EU Framework Programme on Research and Innovation (R&I) 'Horizon Europe' for the period 2023-2024.

General Gov. co-funding conditions?

- Indian entities to comply terms & conditions of respective funding agency (DST/DBT/MoES) ! - see web notice;
- **Proposal not submitted to both funding portals/agencies will be disqualified;**
- Co-funding subject to **positive evaluation** by respective Indian funding agencies;
- Indian entities **not to sign the EC Grant Agreement!**
- Duration: up to 3-4 years;

What is funded by Gol. under co-funding?

(limited to Gol earmarked calls – see list ([click here](#)))

- **100% funding (Grant-in-aid)** → Public or Private academic and/or research institution(s), National/State funded R&D Labs
- **Eligible costs:**
 - Capital expenditure (equipment's)
 - Manpower
 - Consumables
 - Travel (local and international travel)
 - Contingency
 - Overheads
 - Outsourcing
 - others (training & awareness; workshops; publications; review meetings, etc.)
- **IND contribution per project:**
 - DST/MoES: INR 1.5 crores/project (~EUR 160,000/project)
 - DBT: As per requirement of the project

Admissibility: general conditions of Gol.

Application must be:

- **Jointly developed** by EU + India + other partners in prescribed HE template (Part A & B);
- Submitted electronically to **Funding & Tenders Portal electronic submission** system **by the call deadline** (task of European Project Coordinator);
- Submitted to Gol. i.e. **same proposal** as submitted to Horizon Europe F&T Portal + **in annex administrative & financial form required by DST/DBT/MoES**;
- Submitted to DST: by lead Indian scientific coordinator/PI on DST ePMS online portal – within 7 working days after the HE call closing date;
- Submitted to DBT via email - within 7 working days after the HE call closing date;
- Submitted to MoES via email + hard copy - within 7 working days after the HE call closing date;
- Complete and contain all parts and mandatory Annexes and supporting documents must be readable, accessible and printable;


