Note: In the countries marked with an asterisk on the list, partner organisations provide funds for co-financing the partner side. The DFG can only fund project partners in these countries if the partner organisation in the respective country does not provide funding for the project due to budgetary constraints. In some regions of Brazil, partner organisations consistently provide funds to co-finance the partner's contribution, without any restrictions. Project partners from these regions are therefore generally ineligible for DFG funding.

i The DFG compiles the list of developing countries and territories relevant to its funding procedures, based on the DAC list. The Development Assistance Committee (DAC) of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) publishes, at irregular intervals, a list (The DAC List of Aid Recipients) in which individual countries are classified as developing countries and territories or as countries and territories in transition, based on their stage of development and economic strength.
